The Matthew Goniwe School of Leadership and Governance (MGSLG) invites offers from experienced service providers for the maintenance of air conditioners at our Vrededorp and Benoni Campuses. Service providers must submit their offers in this RFQ document.

A non-compulsory site visit to acquaint yourself with the make and models of the air conditioners units will take place at the MGSLG Offices Situated in Vrededorp Branch, 40 Hull Street, JHB, on Wednesday 4 May 2022, starting at 10h00-11h00 and Tuesday, same day for Benoni Branch situated at 55 Elston Avenue, Benoni at 12:30 pm-13h30 pm.

Completed documents must be in a sealed envelope clearly marked with the RFQ name and placed in tender box at: MGSLG Offices, **Physical Address:40 Hull Street**, **Vrededorp**, **Johannesburg** by no later than 12h00 on **Monday 9 May 2022**. Telegraphic, faxed or posted tenders will not be accepted. Bidders must attach the following mandatory returnable documents to be considered for this bid:

- Original and updated Tax Compliance status Pin for verification.
- Certified ID(s) copies of company director(s)
- Proof of company registration
- Company municipal rates, electricity, or water account not older than 3 Months, proof of Residential lease or rental or sworn affidavit if the business operates at a place of residence.
- Completed and signed Standard Bidding Document attached in the tender document.
- Proof of registration on National Treasury Central Supplier database.
- Proof of company banking details e.g., bank letter with bank stamp, Company bank statement, code rating letter from the bank or any physical proof from the bank, the evidence must not be older than three months.
- Proof of registration/membership with applicable governing bodies

Failure to submit all of the above-mentioned document will result to the disqualification of the bid.

EVALUATION PROCESS

Evaluation will be done on the following two-stage process in terms of National Treasury implementation guide Preferential procurement regulations, 2011 pertaining to the preferential procurement policy framework act, act no 5 of 2000.

Preamble

MGSLG intends to maintain and service air-conditioning at both campuses, in order to create a more conducive working environment for employees and stakeholders.

Specification

The appointed service provider/s will be expected to perform on the following scope of work:

The service provider will be required to service and maintain various Air Conditioning systems and units (list attached) within the Vrededorp and Benoni Campuses by carrying out Minor Quarterly services 3 times per year and 1 Major service per year. Service agreement for **36 months**.

1.1 Minor Service Includes:

- Cleaning of filters
- Cleaning of drains
- Cleaning of condensate pumps
- Checking of Operations
- Checking and recording heating and cooling temperatures
- Reporting of any faults found during service
- Cleaning equipment and consumables

1.2 Major Service Includes:

- Cleaning of filters
- Cleaning of coils (with chemical if required)
- Cleaning of units
- Cleaning of condensate pumps
- Lubricate mechanical parts
- Check for gas leaks
- Check for loose electrical connections
- Check compressor and compressor mounting
- Check condition of evaporator coil
- Check condition of condensing coil
- Check condensate tray and drains
- Condensate pump maintenance including decontamination of pump filter
- Check fan blades-Balance/secure
- Check head and suction pressure
- Check fan motor-Running freely/true/bearings/oil where necessary
- Check thermostat's switch and contactors
- Check refrigeration system
- Check amp's- All amp readings comply with manufacturer's specifications
- Clean water seal-leaks

- Measure on and off coil temperatures
- Clean equipment and area.
- Check and report heating and cooling temperatures
- Report on any faults found
- 1.3 All service and maintenance work is envisaged to be attended to during normal working hours. However the service provider will be expected to attend to emergency call outs and work, from time to time when the need arises. The turn-around times for emergency work is to be 48 hours and will be agreed upon between the two parties in a SLA.
- 1.4 All replacement parts/other than what is needed for general servicing shall be for the account of MGSLG. Quotations for work required parts/spares will be submitted to MGSLG for approval prior to work being carried out.
- 1.5 The service provider will make sure that all job sheets are signed off by the MGSLG Facilities Manager upon completion.

CV AND QUALIFICATION OF MAINTENANCE TEAM

The bidder must submit CV and relevant gas practitioner accreditation certificate of personnel who will be responsible for servicing of air-conditioners in the building. Also provide a list of your support personnel capacity for general maintenance and emergency call outs. Points will be scored as follow:
